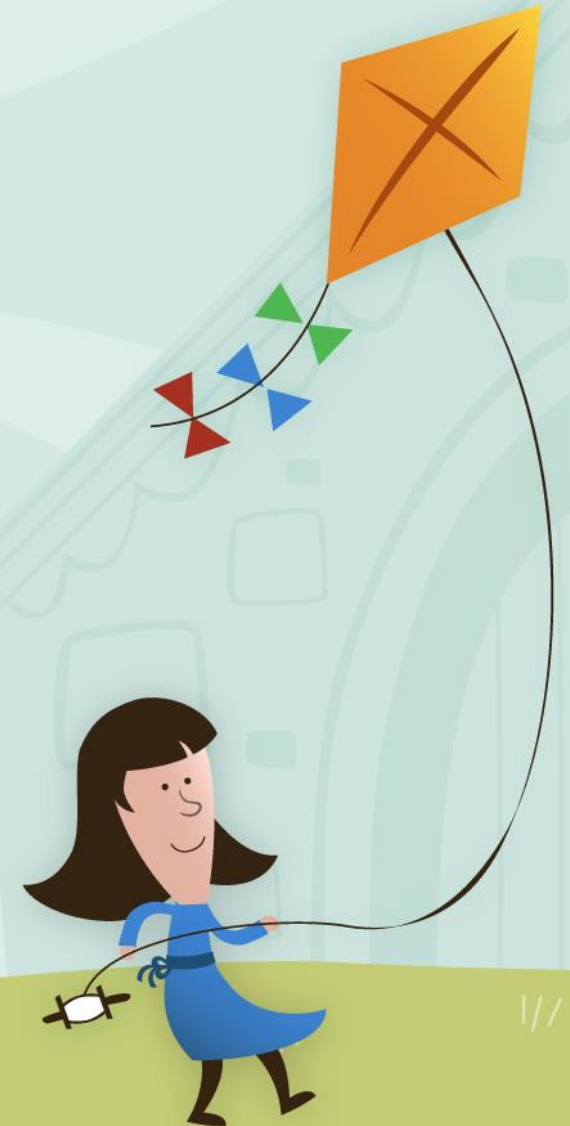

Digital Leaders

- This council works with Mr Davies.
- You help to support your classmates and teachers in Computing lessons.
- You help to make sure that the whole school knows how to keep safe when using technology.

- You will lead an assembly with Mr Davies this year.

Well-being Council

- This council works with Ms Smart.
- The job of this council is to help the school's leadership team make sure that we have lots of ways to support children to be happier and healthier.
- You might help to run well-being campaigns, feedback on initiatives like OPAL and think about things we can do to make sure that we all know what is good for our mental health and well-being.
- You will lead an assembly with Ms Smart at some point this year.
- If you are someone who likes to make people feel good and you understand what helps to make you happy, this is the council for you!



Learning Council

- Miss Jolliffe works with this council of our Pupil Parliament.
- The learning council help the leadership team to understand what learning looks like in every class of the school and how we can make sure that you all get the very best education.
- Sometimes, you will help visit classes and see children learning, you might be involved in speaking to our Governors about life at CRJS and you get to share ways that you think we can improve school for all children.
- You will help Miss Jolliffe to lead an assembly.
- If you enjoy learning and like to share ideas with others then you will enjoy being part of the Learning Council.



Eco Council

- This council works with Miss Chick and Miss Hayer.
- You help to think about our school grounds and how we can be more eco-friendly.
- You might help to run anti-litter campaigns, help the OPAL team with the school grounds, look after the pond area and outdoor environment.
- You will help Miss Chick and Miss Hayer lead an assembly this year.
- If you like looking after the world around you and have ideas about how we can do this even better, then you might like to put yourself forward for this council.
