Year 3	<p>Compulsory: How did Jesus change lives?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To know that a miracle is an unexplained event and has been seen as different things throughout time • To know that Christians believe the Bible tells stories about Jesus performing miracles • To know that Christians believe that Jesus showed he was God’s Son by performing miracles. • To retell the Bible story of the Feeding of the 5000 <p>Compulsory: Why do Christians call God ‘Father’?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To know that Christians believe God has three representations – God the Father, Jesus the Son and the Holy Spirit • To know that Christians believe that God has many titles which show what He is like and to name three out of Rock, Light, Judge, Father, Shepherd or Saviour. • To know that Christians believe they can understand who God is through the parables Jesus told his followers • To know two different ways Christians believe they can experience God – through nature and through prayer. <p>Compulsory: Christmas Y3: Why are presents given at Christmas – and what might Jesus think about it all?</p>	<p>Compulsory: Easter Y3: Easter: what happened – and what matters most to Christians?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To retell the story of Easter from Maundy Thursday to Easter Sunday • To know that Christians call Good Friday ‘good’ because they believe Jesus died to save them • To know that for Christians eggs are a symbol of new life. • To know that for Christians the cross is a symbol of the Jesus’ sacrifice for them and the promise of heaven <p>Comparative: How did it all begin?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To know that many cultures and religions believe that God can be seen in nature. • To know that Christians, Muslims and Jews all believe that God created the world and have similar views about creation. • To retell either the Abrahamic or Muslim creation story. • To know that some people believe that science can explain how the world was created. 	<p>Compulsory: Why do Christians share communion?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To know that Christian communion is linked to the story of Last Supper • To know that communion is act of remembrance • To know that for Christians the bread and wine are a symbol to remember Jesus’ sacrifice and His promise to them <p>Compulsory: How does the Bible reveal God’s rescue plan?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To know that the Bible can be read in many different languages and formats • To know that the Old Testament contains events for which there is some historical evidence • To retell the story of Noah’s Ark • To know that Christians believe that some of these stories show that God will rescue/save them <p>Compulsory: What do Sikhs value?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To know that Guru Nanak Ji founded Sikhism but is not worshipped as a god • To know that the main duties of a Sikh are <i>pray, work and give</i>. • To know that Sikhs believe that God is one and in all things • To know that equality is very important to Sikhs

<p>Year 6</p>	<p>Compulsory: What is the 'golden rule'?- and are they all the same?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that the Golden Rule came not from God, but from our common need to be treated well in order to live together peacefully To know the 'Golden Rule' is to treat others as we want to be treated ourselves. <p>Compulsory: What is the 'Buddhist way of life'?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that Buddhism is a non-theistic religion 	<p>Compulsory: What helps Hindus to worship?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that Hindus believe in a supreme reality (Brahman) that is represented in many different forms. To know that Hindus follow key rituals in the Mandair or at home: ringing bells, offering food, lighting candles To know that Hindus have sacred stories that have morals and meanings e.g. story of Rama and Sita. <p>ASU: What does it mean to be a Hindu?</p>	<p>Compulsory: How is God Three – and yet One?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that Christians believe God is a Trinity – Father, Son and Holy Spirit and to know that this is a belief distinct to Christianity. To know that each element of the Trinity has a distinct character and purpose but that each one is till part of the other two. To know that Christians use symbols to express their beliefs about the Trinity.

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that there are four noble truths - suffering, cause of suffering, end of suffering and the path that leads to the end of suffering. To know the meaning of 'enlightenment' - the state of having knowledge. <p>Compulsory: Christmas Y6: What do the Gospels say about the birth of Jesus – and why is it 'good news'?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that there are similarities and differences between the two birth accounts in the gospels of Matthew and Luke. To know that people experience and recall the same events in different ways To know that Christians believe that the gospels reveal 'good news' (the birth of Christ). 	<p>Compulsory: Adam, Eve, Christmas & Easter: what are the connections?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that Christians believe there are links between Genesis, Easter and Christmas through the Old Testament e.g. it foretells Jesus' birth and death. <p>Compulsory: Easter Y6: Did Jesus have to die?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know that Christians believe that Jesus chose to die as atonement for sin. To know that Christians believe Jesus died to show how much God loves people and wants to be reconciled with them. 	<p>Compulsory: Who did Jesus say 'I AM'?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To know the simple meanings of the different names given to Jesus e.g. Lord, King Emmanuel To know 4 of the 7 'I am' statements To know why Christians believe that Jesus was the Son of God
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
