SMALL CHARITY CONSTITUTION

Suitable for small charities with an annual income under £5,000 that don't own a building or employ people and do not intend to register with the Charity Commission.

1 NAME

The charity's name is Crawley Ridge Junior School Community Trust.

2 THE PURPOSES OF THE CHARITY ARE:-

The provision of educational resources for the sole benefit of the children of Crawley Ridge Junior School, a Community School in Camberley, Surrey.

3 TRUSTEES

The charity shall be managed by a committee of trustees who are appointed at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the charity.

There will be a minimum of 3 trustees, always to comprise of at least one current governor of Crawley Ridge Junior School, one current member of staff of Crawley Ridge Junior School and one current parent of a child at Crawley Ridge Junior School.

In the event that a trustee ceases to hold their designated position as governor, member of staff or parent, trustees will appoint a new trustee at a Trustee Meeting. The departing trustee will then step down as a trustee, but can remain as a member.

4 CARRYING OUT THE PURPOSES

In order to carry out the charitable purposes, the trustees have the power to:

- (1) raise funds, receive grants and donations
- (2) apply funds to carry out the work of the charity
- (3) co-operate with and support other charities with similar purposes
- (4) do anything which is lawful and necessary to achieve the purposes

5 <u>MEMBERSHIP</u>

The charity shall have a membership. People who support the work of the charity and are aged 18 or over, can apply to the trustees to become a member. Once accepted by the trustees, membership lasts for 3 years and may be renewed. The trustees will keep an upto-date membership list.

The trustees may remove a person's membership if they believe it is in the best interests of the charity. The member has the right to be heard by the trustees before the decision is made and can be accompanied by a friend.

6 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING - AGM

- (1) The AGM must be held every year, with 14 days notice given to all members telling them what is on the agenda. Minutes must be kept of the AGM.
- (2) Minutes will be available on the website of Crawley Ridge Junior School School.

- (3) There must be at least 3 members present at the AGM.
- (4) Every member has one vote.
- (5) The trustees shall present the annual report and accounts.
- (6) Any member may stand for election as a trustee.
- (7) Members shall elect between 3 and 10 trustees to serve for the next year. They will retire at the next AGM but may stand for re-election.

7 TRUSTEE MEETINGS

- (1) Trustees must hold at least 3 meetings each year. At their first meeting after the AGM they will elect a chair, treasurer and secretary. Trustees may act by majority decision.
- (2) At least 3 trustees must be present at the meeting to be able to take decisions. Minutes shall be kept for every meeting.
- (3) If trustees have a conflict of interest they must declare it and leave the meeting while this matter is being discussed or decided.
- (4) During the year, the trustees may appoint up to 2 additional trustees. They will stand down at the next AGM.
- (5) The trustees may make reasonable additional rules to help run the charity. These rules must not conflict with this constitution or the law.
- (6) Minutes of Trustee Meetings will be available on the website of Crawley Ridge Junior School.

8 MONEY AND PROPERTY

- (1) Money and property must only be used for the charity's purposes.
- (2) Trustees must keep accounts. The most recent annual accounts can be seen by anybody on request and will be available on the website of Crawley Ridge Junior School.
- (3) Trustees cannot receive any money or property from the charity, except to refund reasonable out of pocket expenses.
- (4) Money must be held in the charity's bank account. All cheques must be signed by 2 trustees.

9 GENERAL MEETINGS

If the Trustees consider it is necessary to change the constitution, or wind up the charity, they must call a General Meeting so that the membership can make the decision. Trustees must also call a General Meeting if they receive a written request from the majority of members. All members must be given 14 days notice and told the reason for the meeting. All decisions require a two thirds majority. Minutes must be kept and will be available on the website of Crawley Ridge Junior School.

- (1) **Winding up -** any money or property remaining after payment of debts must be given to a charity with similar purposes to this one. The charity must be wound up in the event that
 - i. Crawley Ridge Junior School ceases to exist as a Community School.

- ii. The trustees receive unanimous representation from the Full Governing Body of Crawley Ridge Junior School that the Purpose of the charity is not being adhered to.
- (2) **Changes to the Constitution -** can be made at AGMs or General Meetings. No change can be made that would make the organisation no longer a charity.
- (3) **General Meeting -** called on written request from a majority of members.
- (4) Trustees may also call a General Meeting to consult the membership

10 SETTING UP THE CHARITY

This constitution was adopted on 13th December 2015 by the people whose signatures appear below. They are the first members of the charity and will be the trustees until the AGM, which must be held within one year of this date.
