Dear Parents & Carers,

It was lovely to welcome the children back yesterday. They all looked very smart and refreshed after their break. At the end of the day, the teachers were full of praise for their classes and how well all the children had settled.

It was a busy break in the school and, thanks to the hard work of the staff, we now have two new attractive learning areas. One is dedicated to reading and the other is for maths, though the spaces are designed to be flexible. The original refurbishment of these areas was funded by our PTA and I am very grateful to all of you who attended events last year enabling this work to take place.

We also have worked on the grounds and many areas have been cleared. Our wildlife garden at the front of the school is in the final stages of dropping its seed heads and then that area can be trimmed. The Forest School is looking particularly good and we are delighted that all children will get time there this year. We have put together a rolling programme which starts with year 3 next week. The PTA have also funded repairs to the trim trail which is now open for the children to use again. I am talking to companies about adding in some additional pieces of equipment to refresh the trail.

#### **Attendance**

It is a requirement of Surrey County Council that I remind you that children should only be taken out of school in exceptional circumstances. The Isle of Wight case caused some confusion, but Surrey CC considers only 100% attendance to be 'good' attendance. Parents taking children out of school for family holidays are liable to face a penalty notice. Each parent/carer would be subject to the penalty notice.

There has been an increase in requests for time out during term time and attendance levels at the school have declined. I will, therefore, need to be taking a firmer line on absence and children who are persistently late.
