A few weeks ago, the children completed and sent out their formal letters to you regarding our upcoming Henley Fort school trip. We are now looking forward to the trip next week, where the children will experience a memorable day linked closely to their history learning.

Following the letter-writing unit, the children have moved on to—and successfully completed—a new unit on newspaper articles related to World War II, where they explored structure, journalistic style, and factual reporting.

In reading, we have continued with Umbrella Mouse, an exciting story centred around a secret animal resistance during World War II. The children have been deeply engaged with its themes of bravery, resilience, and friendship.

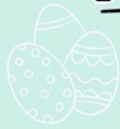
