Spotlight on Year 4

Year 4 relish all opportunities to learn through first-hand experiences and over the last few weeks, they have certainly embraced these.

Before half term, the children thoroughly enjoyed the school sleepover. We were treated to an amazing bird display which included a falcon, a Chilean blue eagle and a six-week-old spectacled owl! The pupils impressed Alan, the bird expert with their enthusiasm and listening skills. Our twilight walk gave us a whole new perspective of the school grounds. We listened to the owls and the rustling of creatures in the undergrowth before returning to the school building for stories before bed. The behaviour of the pupils was exemplary.

In Forest School and science, the children have embarked on bug hunts, tree surveys and pond-dipping to explore living things in our spectacular grounds. We have used our data to sort information into various charts and sorting diagrams.

This week we were privileged to have a visit from Mr Tugwell, a CRJS parent and a medical professional. We were trained in basic first aid including the recovery position and CPR. We learned about the emergency numbers both in the UK and abroad and D.R. A. B. C- Danger, Response, Airway, Breathing, Circulation.
