Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been another fantastic week in school, and I would like to take a moment to recognise our wonderful Year 4 children. They have now completed their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC), and we are incredibly proud of the effort, determination and resilience they have shown throughout this process. Their hard work and commitment will stand them in excellent stead as they move into Upper Key Stage 2, where the maths curriculum relies heavily on a secure understanding of times tables and number facts. Ensuring that children have this strong foundation is so important, and we are delighted to see them so well prepared for the next stage of their learning journey.

We are also beginning to notice a few reminders needed around uniform as we move through this final half term. While we completely understand the warmer weather and that we are nearing the end of the year, we still have several busy weeks ahead and it is important that standards remain high. Trainers should only be worn for PE, with children bringing them to change into at lunchtime. School shoes should be worn during the day, and we are currently seeing an increasing number of children wearing trainers instead. We would really appreciate your support in ensuring the correct uniform is worn each day.
